Staff car parking survey – Foresterhill Health Campus A huge thank you once again to everyone who took the time to complete this survey. There are more than 1,100 individual pieces of feedback to read through and we are working through these at present. Once this work is complete, we will share the results with you, along with the planned next steps. As a reminder, there is no change to current arrangements for staff parking on the site; you may park in the multi-storey car park, using Level 6 and above. Please ensure the lower floors are kept free for patients and visitors, especially those with limited mobility.

Gloves Off – Initial Results of the Staff Questionnaire on the Use of Non-sterile Disposable Gloves (NSDG) Inappropriate glove use contributes to skin damage, and can disrupt good hand hygiene practice, which can lead to increased infections. Let's be glove aware and only wear them when we need to. This will protect staff skin, reduce the risk of transmission of infections, reduce the waste we produce, reduce our carbon footprint and have an improved sustainability and environmental impact.

Thank you again to all of those who took the time to respond to the survey. We are still compiling the full report but have prepared an initial summary which is attached to the Brief, as many of you have been asking about the results.

It is clear is that there is some confusion around when to wear NSDG. Please watch the short video from NHS Education for Scotland and use the poster attached, to help promote the correct use of gloves and our Gloves Off Campaign. The survey will help us to identify other ways in which we can help each other to understand when to wear gloves. Watch this space for more information!
