Winter vaccinations for staff - updated Drop-in vaccination clinics are now taking place across Grampian for healthcare workers. All NHS staff are eligible for flu vaccinations, and staff who come into direct contact with patients are eligible for both COVID-19 and flu vaccinations. Non-patient provisions – end to ordering For many years, the catering department has taken orders from wards/service for supplies such as tea, coffee, and milk. These are separate from patient provisions and typically cross charged. With enhanced scrutiny of spending in all departments and confirmation the finance team will no longer undertake internal cross charging of less than £5000, such ordering will end from the start of January 2025. This will exclude the NHS Grampian Nurseries, the NHS Grampian Charity and a few other areas where there are legislated requirements with separate arrangements in place. Staff teams who have ordered additional supplies in this way should make alternative arrangements. There will be no change to the provision of items such as tea, coffee, milk, etc for patient pantries.
