Interim guidance - supporting patients with mouth care/oral hygiene Concerns have been raised both locally and nationally about current mouth care practices, with reports of areas misinterpreting information concerning mouth care products including their availability/use. As a result, there is an inconsistent approach with potential implications for the provision of high-quality nursing care and patient safety.

<u>A multi-disciplinary Short Life Working Group has developed this interim guidance</u> (networked devices only) on mouthcare products to highlight which products should be avoided and those which are recommended. This is intended for health & social care staff who are involved in supporting patients with mouth care. Work on a comprehensive guidance document is underway which will have evidence-based recommendations as well as links to other resources/education.
