Value & Sustainability update The latest newsletter from the Value & Sustainability programme is attached to the email used to send this brief. Financial Year End 2024/25 – deadline for new job requests, print & promotional materials ordering Any new job requests received by Marketing & Visual Communications (MVC) after 14 February will not be processed until after the end of this financial year.

- Standard job requests received on or before 14<sup>th</sup> February will be processed as normal. However, all requests after this date will be processed at the start of FY25/26 unless otherwise approved by the Marketing & Corporate Communications Director and agreed with the MVC Head of Service.
- You should ensure enough time for any Publication Requirements Management Group (PRMG) processes to be completed.
- Under NHS Grampian's Standing Financial Instructions, payment for goods cannot be made without print/other media being delivered to Central Stores, checked, approved, receipted and invoices sent to Accounts Payable before 31 March (i.e. no pre-payment).

**SCI Store user security maintenance** The way the upcoming version of SCI Store controls security to users is changing and as part of that, a housekeeping exercise is taking place to move all current user-based permissions in SCI Store over to a structured roles-based access control (RBAC) model. It's a behind-the-scenes process to tidy-up the current permission administration and users shouldn't notice any difference. The work is planned to commence on the 12 February and to be completed by 25 February. Access to SCI Store will be available throughout the planned work.

Any issues to your permissions access in SCI Store should be raised as normal through the IT Service Desk.

**2023-24 Discretionary Points – applications open** We are progressing the 2023-24 Discretionary Points round for all eligible consultants. Eligible consultants should have received an email invite. **Today - International Day of Zero Tolerance for Female Genital Mutilation (FGM)** FGM denies women and girls their dignity, endangers their health, and causes needless pain and suffering, with consequences that endure for a lifetime. To mark the day, specialist midwife Jenni Smith has prepared this article on what a healthcare professional should be aware of and the key risk factors for women and girls being affected by FGM. Aberdeen City Council parking voucher scheme to end Aberdeen City Council have advised they are removing the option for using parking vouchers to pay for on-street parking from August 2025. A limited number of books are still available from ARI general office; once these are gone, they're gone. If you have purchased several books to have on hand, these must be used before 31 August 2025 as they will no longer be valid for use after that date.

On-street parking can be paid for at meters using the Paybyphone or RingGo apps. Please note, **none** of the council meters use QR codes for these services; any QR codes on meters are likely to be fraudulent and should not be used.
